

## **CROOKS ROAD RESURFACING TO START SEPT. 6 IN TROY**

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) will resurface Crooks Road between Banmoor Street (about a third of a mile north of Big Beaver Road) and Fountain Street (about a third of a mile north of Wattles Road) in Troy.

### **PROJECT DETAILS**

This project will include milling off the top layer of asphalt followed by the application of three inches of new asphalt. Curbs and gutters will be repaired as needed throughout the project.

The project also will include upgrading pedestrian crosswalks and bus stops to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. Additionally, the traffic signal at McManus Street will be reconstructed.

The project will provide a smooth new road surface and is expected to extend the useful life of the road by approximately 15 years.

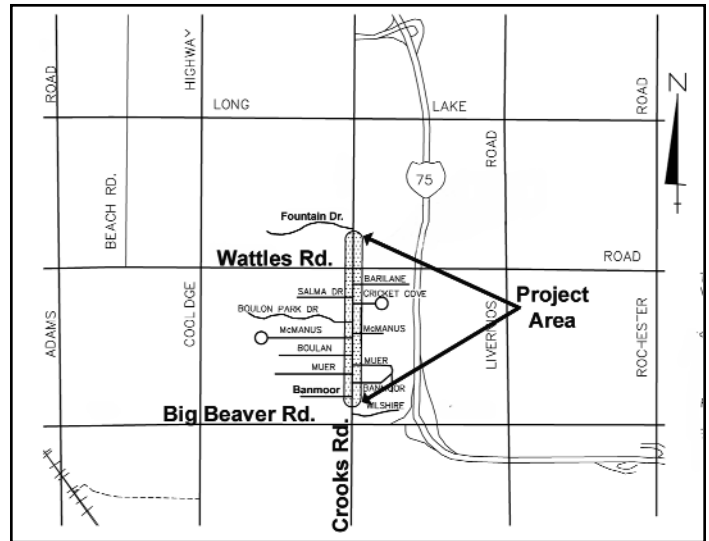

### **IMPACT ON TRAFFIC**

During the project, Crooks Road will remain open to traffic at all times but will be reduced to one lane in each direction. There will be delays at times, particularly during rush hours. Access to all homes and

businesses along the road will be maintained at all times, and access to side streets will also be maintained at all times.

Motorists traveling to destinations outside the construction zone are encouraged to use an alternate route.

### **PROJECT COST & FUNDING**

This project is expected to cost approximately \$1.2 million. Of that, 80 percent will be paid for with federal funds. The remaining 20 percent of the cost is being shared between RCOC and the City of Troy.
