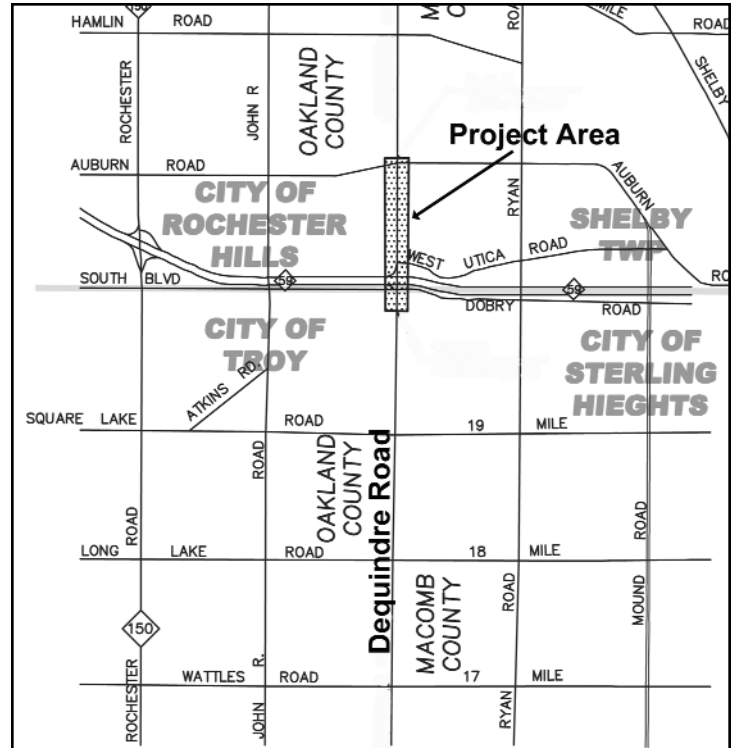


DEQUINDRE RESURFACING, SOUTH BLVD. TO AUBURN RD., TO START APPROX. SEPT. 6

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in conjunction with the the City of Troy, the City of Rochester Hills, the Charter Township of Shelby, Macomb County Roads Department and Oakland County general government, will resurface Dequindre Road from just south of South Boulevard to Auburn Road on the Rochester Hills/Shelby Township and Troy/Sterling Heights border.

PROJECT DETAILS

This project will involve asphalt repaving to provide a smooth new road surface and safety enhancements. Work will include base repairs and the application of three inches of new asphalt.

The project also includes new curbs and gutters at side streets and pedestrian-crosswalk upgrades to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

PROJECT SCHEDULE

START: Approx. Sept. 6, 2011

END: By Nov. 15, 2011

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

For part of the project, there will be at least one lane open in each direction of this section of Dequindre Road. However, in the two lane portion of the road, there will be times when the road is reduced to one lane

of traffic. In those instances, two-directional traffic will be maintained, but will be directed by a flagger. Motorists should expect delays or plan to use an alternate route.

PROJECT COST & FUNDING

The total project cost is expected to be \$1.62 million. Of that amount, \$1.13 million will be paid for with federal funds.

The remaining costs will be split between RCOC, the City of Troy, the Macomb County Roads Department, Shelby Township, the City of Rochester Hills and Oakland County general government.
