



## **PARKING COMMERCIAL VEHICLES IN THE STREET - Chapter 106 – Traffic**

8.25 (4) It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any commercial vehicle, truck or trailer, to park the same for a period exceeding one hour upon any residential street in the City of Troy, unless such vehicles are being used for the purpose of delivering or picking up goods, wares, merchandise or materials or is being used in connection with servicing any residences located adjacent to the street upon which said vehicles are parked and then only for such period as is necessary to complete the service.

Commercial vehicles shall be defined as every motor vehicle used for transportation of passengers for hire, or constructed or used for transportation of goods, construction materials, wares or merchandise. Provided, however, that this shall not include camping trucks, trailers and other such vehicles used for recreational purposes only.
