

Troy MLK Day Committee announces its 12th annual

Short Essay Contest



Topic:

“Walking in Greatness -- What would Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. think of America today?”

Eligible participants: Students in grades 6-12. You must be a Troy resident.

Essay length: No longer than 150 words.

Directions: Your entry should be typed and double spaced. Put a cover sheet on your entry with your name, address, school, grade, phone number and parent/guardian’s name.

Announcement of winners: The Troy MLK Day Committee will notify the winning entrants by phone by January 16. Winners **must be available** on January 21, 2013 to read the essay at the MLK Day Celebration of Freedom program from 8:30-11 am at Athens High School.

Award for winners: First place: \$50 and a free bowling party at Troy Lanes or Bowl One for up to 10 people courtesy of Community Bowling Centers. Dates must be arranged in advance between the winners and the Bowling Lane manager. Second place: \$25 and free bowling party.

Prize for all entrants: Every entrant will receive a Troy Lanes/Bowl One family coupon (First game free for up to five people.)
