### **Crime Alert for period ending June 7, 2013**

#### **Auto/Vehicle Thefts**

**1000 block of John R, 5/28/13 – 5/29/13, 7 pm – 3 pm:** The complainant's silver Ford Escort was stolen from the west parking lot of his apartment complex.

**2000 block of John R, 5/27/13 – 5/28/13, 10:30 pm – 7:15 am:** The complainant reports that his black Nissan Armada was stolen from the parking lot.

#### **Breaking & Entries**

**Lucky's Market, 4835 John R, 5/26/13, 5:19 am:** Troy Officers were dispatched to the business on an activated burglary alarm. Upon arrival, officers discovered the front glass door had been smashed and the building had been entered. A cash register containing money was stolen.

#### **Crash Investigations**

**I-75 & W Big Beaver, 5/28/13, 5:32 pm:** Troy Officers responded to a parking lot near I-75 and Big Beaver Road on a hit and run accident report. The complainant stated he had been involved in a non-injury accident on I-75 and both involved vehicles exited the freeway and pulled into a parking lot. When he called the police to report the accident, the other driver got back into his vehicle and drove off. The complainant was able to record the vehicle's license plate number. Oakland County Sheriff Department was contacted and responded to the home of the vehicle's registered owner. The driver, a 51-year-old Lake Orion man, was detained until Troy Police could make the scene. He was arrested for "Driving While License Suspended" and "Leaving the Scene of an Accident." He has three prior convictions for Driving While License Suspended.

**I-75 & W Big Beaver, 5/28/13, 6:06 pm:** Troy Officers received a report a witness was following a vehicle which had fled after being involved in a non-injury accident on I-75. The witness reported the fleeing vehicle had pulled into a parking lot near the Crooks Road exit of I-75. Officers located the vehicle and made contact with the driver. The 47-year-old Southfield man admitted to being involved in an accident and stated he did not have a valid driver's license. He was arrested for "Driving While License Suspended" and "Leaving the Scene of an Accident." He also has four outstanding warrants issued by other area departments.

#### **Credit, Check, Identity Theft, Other Fraud**

**1000 block of Kirts, 5/31/13, 8 am:** Complainant reports when he tried to arrange for Comcast service he learned someone had used his identity to open two fraudulent Comcast accounts. One account is at an address in Clinton Township; the other is in Detroit. The fraudulent accounts are

\$2709.25 in arrears.

**Henry Ford Medical Center, 2825 Livernois, 5/29/13, 2:19 pm:** Officers were dispatched to the site when the pharmacy reported a woman was attempting to pick-up a fraudulent prescription. Following an investigation Troy Officers arrested the 50-year-old Farmington Hills woman for "Obtain Medication by False Pretenses." She admitted she was addicted to the medication and takes 30 pills a day. She found the doctor's name and number in the phone book and called the prescription into the pharmacy pretending she worked for the doctor. The pharmacy called the doctor's office to confirm the prescription and learned that it was fraudulent.

**6000 block of Forest Park, 5/7/13 – 5/8/13:** Complainant states his Capital One credit card number was used to make over \$3800 in fraudulent purchases. The purchases were made in Florida.

**Livernois & W Big Beaver, 5/29/13, 11:23 pm:** A Troy Officer stopped a vehicle which was driving erratically and had its hazard lights on. The driver stated she was having transmission trouble. The officer determined her driver's license was suspended and she had three outstanding warrants for her arrest. A Visa card and a sales receipt corresponding to the card were found in her purse. The card was not in the driver's name. She told officers her daughter found the card several months ago. Officers were able to make contact with the true card holder and she stated she did not give anyone permission to obtain or use a credit card in her name. The driver, a 26-year-old Detroit resident, was arrested for "Driving While License Suspended and "Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card."

**2000 block of Golfview, 3/13/13:** When the complainant received a Verizon bill in the mail, she contacted the company to advise them she did not have a Verizon account. She was informed someone in College Park, Maryland used her identity to open an account on 3/13/13. Over \$2000 is due.

### **Domestic/Family Trouble**

Troy Officers responded to eight incidents involving domestic disputes or family troubles during this reporting period. On-scene investigation of these incidents did not result in evidence of crimes being committed; however, Officers were required to take non-enforcement actions to either mediate the situation or keep the peace. Readers should be aware that although these incidents did not result in arrest or prosecution, they do represent significant law enforcement resources in terms of time, on-scene investigation, potential relocation of disputants, referrals to support agencies, peace keeping, as well as detective and prosecutorial review.

### **Drugs/Narcotics**

**Troy Harmony & Lakewood, 5/31/13, 5:13 am:** Troy Officers responded to the area when a neighbor reported several suspicious persons walking between a car and Baker Middle School. Officers located the vehicle occupied by three males. Following an investigation two arrests were made. A 20-year-old Sterling Heights resident was arrested for "Possession of a Controlled Substance" (prescription pain medication), "Possession of Marijuana" and "Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia." A 19-year-old Troy resident was arrested for "Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia" and "Possession of Marijuana." The third vehicle occupant was released at the scene.

**Grandhaven & John R, 5/29/13, 1:24 am:** After Troy Officers stopped a vehicle for a routine traffic violation, the front seat passenger was found to be in possession of marijuana and narcotic paraphernalia. Initially, the 45-year-old Detroit woman provided officers with a fake name. She was arrested for "Possession of Marijuana," "Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia" and "Hinder and Obstruct a Police Officer." She also has eight outstanding warrants issued by other are

departments.

### **Driving Under Influence of Alcohol/Drugs**

**Chicago & E Maple, 5/31/13, 5:50 am:** Troy Officers were dispatched to the intersection on report of an injury accident. Officers determined a vehicle traveling northbound on Chicago had failed to stop for a flashing red light and had struck a vehicle which was westbound on Maple. The driver of the westbound vehicle was transported to an area hospital by family members. The at-fault driver was not injured. The 49-year-old Madison Heights male had slurred speech and appeared to be confused. He had trouble staying awake and admitted to being "heavily medicated." After failing sobriety tests, he was arrested for "Operating under the Influence of Drugs." A blood test was administered and results are pending.

**Allegheny & Fairfield, 6/1/13, 2:33 am:** A Troy Officer was dispatched to the area when a complaint was received in which a vehicle was driving recklessly through the subdivision and the driver was yelling out the window. The vehicle was located and stopped. The driver stated that he was trying to find his girlfriend who had gotten lost after he let her out of the car to urinate. The driver had slurred speech, glassy/blood eyes and smelled of intoxicants. He failed sobriety tests and marijuana and narcotic paraphernalia were found in this vehicle. The 25-year-old Sterling Heights resident was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated," "Possession of Marijuana" and "Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia." Breath test results were .15%. At about that same time, a neighbor called to report a female was crying and trying to get into his home through the sliding patio door. It was determined the woman was the suspect's girlfriend and she thought she lived at the home. She was transported to the police station and made arrangements for a ride home.

**I-75 & W Fourteen Mile, 6/2/13, 2:48 am:** Troy Officers stopped a vehicle they observed driving erratically. The driver had very badly slurred speech, bloodshot/glassy eyes and smelled of intoxicants. The 30-year-old Clawson resident exhibited poor balance and failed sobriety tests. He was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated" and breath test results were .13%.

**I-75 & Rochester, 6/3/13, 2:27 am:** Troy Officers stopped a vehicle which was not maintaining its lane of travel and repeatedly crossed lane markers on both the right and left. The driver stated that he was weaving because he was drunk and underage. The 18-year-old Hamtramck resident smelled of intoxicants, had slurred speech and very bloodshot/glassy eyes. He was unable to correctly recite the alphabet. Officers arrested him for "Operating While Intoxicated" and breath test results were .13%.

**I-75 & Crooks, 5/31/13, 12:56 am:** Troy Officers observed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed nearly rear-end the vehicle in front of it. The high speed driver had to brake hard to avoid a collision. The vehicle was stopped and officers noted the driver appeared to be extremely intoxicated. The 26-year-old New Baltimore man smelled strongly of intoxicants, had very bloodshot/glassy eyes and extremely slurred speech. He was unable to recite the alphabet and did not want to attempt any sobriety tests, stating he knew he was too drunk. He was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated" and breath tests were .25% - more than three times the legal limit.

**I-75 & W Long Lake, 5/31/13, 2:15 am:** A Troy Officer stopped a vehicle he observed weaving. The vehicle was occupied by three males and smelled strongly of marijuana. When the officer asked where the marijuana was the driver stated they had smoked it all. The 19-year-old Hamtramck resident failed sobriety tests and was arrested for "Operating under the Influence of Drugs." A blood test was administered and results are pending. The passengers in the vehicle were released without charges.

**I-75 & Fourteen Mile, 5/27/13, 3:19 pm:** A Troy Officer was dispatched to a report of a suspected drunk driver on I-75. The vehicle had already been involved in an accident in Madison Heights and

was reportedly driving in all three lanes of the freeway. The officer located the vehicle when it exited the freeway at Rochester Road. The vehicle stopped for the red light at Big Beaver Road and the driver appeared to fall asleep. Approximately 30 seconds after the light cycled to green, the driver woke up and began driving. The officer observed the vehicle swerving over lane markers and performed a traffic stop. The driver, a 50-year-old Rochester man, admitted to taking prescription pain and anti-anxiety medication which he said may have affected his driving. He failed sobriety tests and was arrested for "Operating under the Influence of Drugs." A blood test was administered and results are pending.

**I-75 & Adams, 5/24/13, 10:29 pm:** A Troy Officer stopped a vehicle traveling 95 miles-per-hour on I-75. The driver smelled slightly of intoxicants and had difficulty maintaining his balance. The 25-year-old male from Rochester Hills was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated" and breath test results were .11%.

**Rochester & E Big Beaver, 5/25/13, 3:20 am:** Troy Officers stopped a vehicle unable to maintain its lane of travel, crossing lane markers, and at times straddling two lanes. The driver smelled of intoxicants, had bloodshot/glassy eyes and slurred speech. The 26-year-old Ortonville woman failed sobriety tests and was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated." Breath test results were .18%.

**6000 block of Forest Park, 5/25/13, 8:04 am:** A Troy Officer responded to a Malicious Destruction of Property report. The officer observed vehicle skid marks on the roadway and across the lawn. A small tree had been run over and an AT&T junction box ripped from its base. The officer located a vehicle parked nearby with fresh accident damage and dirt/grass all over two sides. The driver was asleep behind the wheel with the keys in the ignition. He was woken and the officer noted he had bloodshot/watery eyes and smelled strongly of intoxicants. Following an investigation, the 20-year-old Troy resident was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated." Breath test results were .13%.

**I-75 & Crooks, 5/25/13, 10:19 pm:** Troy Officers were dispatched to the area after a citizen reported a suspected drunk driver. Officers located the vehicle and confirmed it was weaving and crossing lane markers. When the vehicle was stopped, officers noted the driver smelled of intoxicants and had bloodshot eyes. The 32-year-old Detroit male said he had been at Belle Isle and was on his way to "Fifteen and Harper." When asked where he was now, the driver said he was on I-94. He failed sobriety tests and was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated 3rd offense" and "Driving While License Revoked second offense." Breath test results were .15%.

**I-75 & Rochester, 5/26/13, 2:42 am:** A Troy Officer was assisting a broken down motorist on the right shoulder of I-75 when a vehicle passed the patrol car, which had its overhead emergency lights activated. The passing vehicle failed to move over into the center lane though there was ample opportunity to do so. The vehicle drifted toward the patrol vehicle as it passed. The officer noticed the vehicle was crossing lane markers and driving in more than one lane at a time. When the vehicle was stopped the officer found the driver had slurred speech, smelled of intoxicants and was unable to correctly recite the alphabet. The 43-year-old Lake Orion male had poor balance and failed sobriety tests. He was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated" and "Driving While License Suspended." Breath test results were .12%.

**I-75 & Rochester, 5/27/13, 2:41 am:** Troy Officers responded to the area after a citizen reported a suspected drunk driver northbound on I-75. Officers located the vehicle and confirmed it was unable to maintain its lane of travel and repeatedly crossed lane markers. When the vehicle was stopped, the officers noted the driver smelled of intoxicants, had slurred speech and very bloodshot/glassy eyes. The driver's balance was so poor officers discontinued sobriety tests as they feared he would fall and injure himself. The 37-year-old Clarkston resident was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated" and breath test results were .18%.

The complainant and his 20-year-old son sustained minor injuries.

**Henry Ford Medical Center, 2825 Livernois, 5/20/13, 10 am – 8:15 pm:** The catalytic converter was cut off and stolen from the complainant's Pontiac Montana.

**Ryder Truck Rental, 755 Stephenson, 5/26/13 – 5/27/13, 5 pm – 9 pm:** The complainant parked her 2012 Dodge Challenger at the business. When she returned to pick it up, all four wheels and tires had been stolen and the car was on cement blocks.

### **Retail Fraud**

**Kohl's, 500 John R, 5/31/13, 5:44 pm:** Kohl's Loss Prevention contacted police dispatch and reported a male had stolen 2 tank tops and a pair of shorts. When they attempted to detain the man he ignored them and got into his vehicle and drove away. Troy Officers located and stopped the suspect vehicle. The 19-year-old Saint Clair Shores resident was arrested for "Retail Fraud III". The stolen merchandise was recovered from his vehicle and returned to the store.

**Foot Action, 614 W Fourteen Mile, 6/2/13, 12:20 pm:** Police Dispatch received a phone call from Mr Alan's, 348 W Fourteen Mile, reporting a retail fraud had just occurred in their store, however, the suspect left before he could be apprehended. Mall Security was notified and found the suspect inside of Foot Action. After he left that store, management realized he had stolen a Nike t-shirt. A Troy Officer stopped the suspect in the parking lot as he was driving away. He initially provided a false name to the officer. When he was fingerprinted his true identity was revealed. A store employee at Mr Alan's was interviewed and stated the suspect stole three shirts and a pair of shorts from their store. The merchandise stolen at Foot Action and Mr Alan's was recovered from the suspect's vehicle. The suspect was charged with two counts of "Retail Fraud," "Driving While License Suspended" and "Hinder and Obstruct a Police Officer by False Identification." A 22-year-old Warren man, who was a passenger in the car, was arrested for "Possession of Marijuana."

**Home Goods, 624 John R, 5/29/13, 3:10 pm:** Home Goods Loss Prevention called Police Dispatch and reported a woman was leaving the store with stolen merchandise concealed in her purse. A Troy Officer arrived on the scene and stopped the vehicle the woman was leaving in. The woman exited the vehicle and shoved the bag containing the stolen merchandise at the officer and stated "I can't go to jail." The purse contained \$499.94 worth of stolen Kate Spade bedding. When the officer attempted to handcuff her she became combative and assaulted the officer. The 23-year-old Detroit resident was arrested and charged with "Assault and Battery – Police Officer" and "Retail Fraud II." She also has an outstanding warrant related to a previous conviction for retail fraud.

**Kohl's, 1265 Coolidge, 5/27/13, 1:23 pm:** A 28-year-old Hazel Park male was arrested for "Retail Fraud III" after shoplifting seven t-shirts, valued at \$55.86.

**Macy's, 500 W Fourteen Mile, 5/28/13, 2:44 pm:** An 18-year-old Troy woman was arrested for "Retail Fraud III" after shoplifting four shirts with a retail value of \$93.60.

**Nordstrom, 2850 W Big Beaver, 5/25/13, 9:30 pm:** Troy Officers arrested a 24-year-old Royal Oak woman for "Retail Fraud III" after she switched price tags on two skirts. She removed the price tag from the skirt she wished to purchase and replaced it with a lower priced tag from another item. She then went to a register and said she wanted to exchange the incorrectly tagged skirt for one she removed from her shopping bag. That skirt was also incorrectly tagged and the woman did not have a receipt or any proof of purchase for the item. Her 4-year-old child was with her during the incident.

### **Weapons Offense**

**Stephenson & E Maple, 5/30/13, 12:14 am:** Officers stopped to investigate a vehicle which they had observe park in the lot of a closed gas station. During the investigation, marijuana and a loaded handgun were found in the vehicle. The driver does not have a Concealed Pistol License. The 39-year-old Detroit man was arrested and charged with "Possession of Marijuana" and "Carrying a Concealed Weapon."
