### Crime Alert for period ending June 21, 2013

#### Assist Other Departments/Law Enforcement

**6/06/13, 2:14 am:** A Troy Officer and his K-9 partner, Tiko, assisted Birmingham PD by conducting a K-9 track at the scene of a Larceny from Auto.

#### Credit, Check, Identity Theft, Other Fraud

**2000 block of Shadywood, 6/1/13, 9 am – 1 pm:** Complainant reports he placed two pieces of mail, each containing a personal check, in his mailbox for pick-up by the mail carrier. Neither item reached its intended destination. On 6/7/13, he learned another area police department had arrested an individual who was in possession of one of the complainant's missing personal checks. It is believed the suspect intended to use the account information to make counterfeit checks. The investigation is on-going and prosecution is expected.

**6000 block of Crabapple, 6/5/13, 2:00 pm:** Elderly complainants report that they received a phone call from someone who claimed to be their grandson. The caller said he was in jail in Maryland for drunk driving and needed \$3200 for bond money. Shortly after the first call, they received a second call from a subject claiming to be the grandson's attorney. The complainant's advised the "attorney" that they could not afford \$3200, but they did agree to send \$1795. The couple sent \$1795 to the Dominican Republic via Western Union before realizing they had been scammed. They did not verify the story before sending the money because the fake "grandson" had asked them not to tell his parents.

**Macy's, 500 W Fourteen Mile, 6/7/13, 7:39 pm:** Troy Officers arrested a 31-year-old Southfield man for Fraudulent Use of a Financial Transaction Device. The 31-year-old attempted to purchase nineteen articles of Polo clothing, which has a retail value of \$1688, using the Macy's credit account of a 77-year-old Jacksonville, Florida man. The Jacksonville man confirmed he did not give anyone permission to use his account.

**3000 block of Dominique, 5/28/13, 10:31 am:** When the complainant received a bill for \$531.38 from Verizon Wireless she contacted the company and learned someone had used her name and social security number to purchase five smart phones.

**6000 block of Tamarack, 5/29/13, 1 pm:** Complainant reports someone used his identity to open a Home Depot charge card. A fraudulent \$7000 purchase was made using the card.

**3000 block of Cedar Crest, 5/29/13:** Complainant reports that three unauthorized purchases were made using his credit union debit card number. All three purchases were made in Columbus, Ohio.

## **Domestic/Family Trouble**

Troy Officers responded to 12 incidents involving domestic disputes or family troubles during this reporting period. On-scene investigation of these incidents did not result in evidence of crimes being committed; however, Officers were required to take non-enforcement actions to either mediate the situation or keep the peace. Readers should be aware that although these incidents did not result in arrest or prosecution, they do represent significant law enforcement resources in terms of time, on-scene investigation, potential relocation of disputants, referrals to support agencies, peace keeping, as well as detective and prosecutorial review.

## **Drugs/Narcotics**

**Jaycee Park, 1775 E Long Lake, 6/6/13, 5:22 pm:** Troy Officers were dispatched to the park when a caller reported two men playing with a handgun near a baseball diamond. The caller reported one of the men had put the handgun in the trunk of a car. Officers located and made contact with the man. He advised officers the handgun in question was actually a BB gun. Officers checked the item and confirmed that it was a BB gun. When checking the BB gun officers found beer, marijuana and narcotic paraphernalia in the trunk of the car. The 18-year-old Troy man was arrested for "Minor in Possession of Alcohol," "Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia" and "Possession of Marijuana."

**I-75 & W Fourteen Mile, 6/7/13, 11:01 pm:** A Troy Officer stopped a vehicle which was observed leaving its lane of travel and driving completely on the shoulder of the roadway. Following an investigation, both the driver and a passenger in the vehicle were arrested. The driver, an 18-year-old Troy male, was arrested for "Possession of a Hallucinogen" (psilocybin mushrooms), "Possession of Marijuana" and "Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia." The passenger, an 18-year-old female from Troy, was arrested for "Possession of a Controlled Substance." She does not have a prescription for the medication, used to treat ADHD, which she was in possession of.

**E Big Beaver & Rochester, 6/10/13, 12:37 am:** After Troy Officers stopped a vehicle which had a headlight out, they discovered the driver had a suspended license and no insurance. The vehicle smelled of marijuana and an investigation revealed the driver had given two baggies of marijuana to a 15-year-old male, who was a passenger in the vehicle, and told him to hide them in his shoe. The 15-year-old was not charged, however the driver, a 29-year-old Detroit woman, was arrested for "Possession of Marijuana," "Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor" and "Driving While License Suspended." She admitted to asking the 15-year-old to hide the marijuana for her during the traffic stop.

## **Driving Under Influence of Alcohol/Drugs**

**W Big Beaver & Crooks, 6/14/13, 10:36 pm:** Troy Officers were dispatched to an injury accident near Big Beaver and Crooks. Upon arrival, officers spoke with the driver of the vehicle that was not at-fault in the accident. He stated that he was eastbound on Big Beaver when a vehicle that was in a turnaround for traffic going from westbound to eastbound Big Beaver suddenly turned out in front of his vehicle. He was unable to avoid striking the SUV. There is a traffic light at the turnaround. The vehicle in the turnaround had disregarded the flashing red light. Officers spoke with the at-fault driver who appeared to be extremely intoxicated. She had very poor balance, slurred speech and was lethargic. She admitted to drinking "less than a pint". The 20 year-old Rochester Hills resident was transported to an area hospital with minor injuries. A blood test was administered and "Operating While Intoxicated" charges are pending. She has one prior drinking and driving conviction.

**Livernois & Town Center, 6/14/13, 11:27 pm:** Troy OfficerS responded to a report of an injury accident at Livernois and Town Center. A witness reported that a vehicle had run off the roadway, for no apparent reason, striking the guardrail. Officers arrived on the scene and found that the driver

was disoriented and confused. The 32 year-old Sterling Heights resident stated that he took pain medication for back problems. He was transported to an area hospital with non life-threatening injuries. At the hospital, the driver told officers that he had taken 2 prescription pain pills earlier in the evening. He remembered leaving the area of Fifteen Mile and VanDyke, but did not remember anything between that point and being put into the ambulance. A blood test was administered and an "Operating under the Influence of Drugs" charge is pending.

**Dequindre & E Big Beaver, 6/15/13, 2:48 am:** Troy Officers observed two vehicles exit an area fast food establishment when one began driving recklessly, swerving at the other. The swerving vehicle was stopped and the driver apologized for swerving at the other vehicle, explaining that his cousin was in the other car. He smelled of intoxicants and had bloodshot/glassy eyes. The 22 year-old Troy resident was uncooperative, refusing to put down his cheeseburger and exit the vehicle. A passenger in the vehicle finally took the driver's cheeseburger away from him. The driver, continuing to be uncooperative, failed sobriety tests and was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated". Blood test results are pending.

**I-75 & Crooks, 6/15/13, 11:37 pm:** A Troy Officer stopped a vehicle that he observed traveling at 85 miles per hour and weaving within its lane. The vehicle smelled strongly of marijuana and the officer asked the driver if he had been smoking marijuana. The driver explained that he had smoked all of his marijuana while at a local concert venue that evening. Marijuana and narcotic paraphernalia associated with marijuana use were found in the vehicle. The 20 year-old Holly resident failed sobriety tests and was arrested for "Operating under the Influence of Drugs", "Possession of Marijuana" and "Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia". A blood test was administered and results are pending.

**I-75 & Crooks, 6/15/13, 11:55 pm:** A concerned citizen reported that they were following a vehicle that was drifting between lanes and Troy Officers were dispatched to the area. Officers located the vehicle and confirmed that it was not maintaining its lane and repeatedly crossed over lane markers. When the vehicle was stopped, officers found that the driver smelled of intoxicants and had slurred speech. When the 24 year-old Royal Oak man was unable to correctly recite the alphabet correctly he became visibly frustrated with himself. A bottle of prescription pain killers, not prescribed to the driver, were found in his pants pocket. He was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated" and "Possession of a Controlled Substance". Breath test results were .18%.

**I-75 & Fourteen Mile, 6/16/13, 12:55 am:** An officer was dispatched to I-75 when a citizen reported they were following a vehicle that was weaving all over the roadway. The officer located the suspect vehicle and confirmed that it was swerving from lane to lane and at times straddling two lanes. The vehicle was stopped and the officer found that the driver had glassy eyes, slurred speech, smelled of intoxicants and was very confused. When asked to exit the vehicle, the driver was extremely unbalanced, almost falling to the ground, and leaned against his vehicle for support. After failing the first sobriety test, the driver refused to attempt any others. Marijuana was located in his vehicle, and the 34 year-old Clinton Township man was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated" and "Possession of Marijuana". A blood test was administered; results are pending. The driver has two previous convictions for drinking and driving.

**I-75 & Crooks, 6/16/13, 2:48 am:** A Troy Officer was dispatched to the area when a citizen reported a suspected drunk driver northbound on I75. The officer located the vehicle and confirmed that it was swerving and crossing the right lane marker. The officer stopped the vehicle and made contact with the driver. The 19 year-old Oakland Township man smelled of intoxicants, had bloodshot/glassy eyes and could not correctly recite the alphabet. He failed sobriety tests and was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated". Breath test results were .11%.

**100 block of Forthton, 6/16/13, 11:32 pm:** A resident called Troy Police after a vehicle backed out of a neighbor's driveway, struck a parked car, and then left the scene. Shortly thereafter, officers

located a vehicle matching the description of the suspect vehicle and noted that the SUV had crash damage and paint transfer from the vehicle that had been struck. The driver admitted to striking the parked vehicle and stated that she had just taken her friend out to get cigarettes. The 61 year-old Troy woman had very poor balance, extremely bloodshot/glassy eyes and admitted to drinking two bottles of wine. After failing sobriety tests, she was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated". Breath test results were .18%.

**Dequindre & E Fourteen Mile, 6/17/13, 3:57 am:** Troy Officers stopped a suspicious vehicle which they had observed pull into the parking lot of two closed and dark businesses. When officers made contact with the driver they noted that she smelled of intoxicants and had slurred speech. Following an investigation the 20 year-old Sterling Heights resident was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated and "Driving While License Suspended. Breath test results were .08%. The 20 year-old has two previous arrests for drinking and driving.

**Crooks & W Long Lake, 6/6/13, 11:59 pm:** A citizen telephoned Troy Dispatch after observing a man stumble out of a convenience store, get into a car, and drive away. The citizen was on the phone with police when the vehicle he was following crashed into a road sign. The citizen stood by until Troy Police arrived. Officers made contact with the suspected drunk driver who had glassy eyes, smelled of intoxicants and difficulty standing up on his own. After failing sobriety tests, the 25-year-old Troy male was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated 2nd Offense." A blood test was administered.

**Rochester & E Long Lake, 6/7/13, 12:36 am:** Troy Officer was dispatched to the area after a citizen reported a suspected drunk driver. A Troy Officer located and stopped the suspect vehicle. The driver had slurred speech, bloodshot eyes and smelled of intoxicants. When asked for her driver's license, the driver gave the officer a debit card. After performing poorly on sobriety tests, the 31-year-old Shelby Township resident was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated." Breath test results were .13%.

**I-75 & Rochester, 6/7/13, 12:41 am:** Troy Dispatch received a phone call from a driver who stated he was following a vehicle which had struck his vehicle and then fled the scene. A neighboring jurisdiction, monitoring Troy PD radio transmissions, located and stopped the hit-and-run vehicle. The driver had poor balance and slurred speech. He provided officers with a name which was later determined to be false. Narcotic paraphernalia, marijuana, a partially full bottle of vodka, various prescription pills (later determined to be controlled substances), and a "Batman" shaped hand held edged weapon were found in the hit-and-run vehicle. When the driver's real name was determined through fingerprinting it was discovered he has two outstanding Troy warrants. Troy Officers arrested the 24-year-old Troy resident for "Operating under the Influence of Drugs," "Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia," "Possession of Marijuana," "Open intoxicants in a Motor Vehicle," "Possession of a Controlled Substance," "Hinder and Obstruct a Police Officer by False Identification," "Failure to Stop and Identify at an Accident" and "Carrying a Concealed Weapon." A blood test was administered and results are pending.

**I-75 & W Wattles, 6/9/13, 2:03 am:** Troy Officers stopped a vehicle that was having difficulty maintaining its lane of travel and crossed lane markers several times. When contact was made with the driver, officers noted the strong odor of marijuana and intoxicants coming from within the vehicle. The driver had very bloodshot/glassy eyes and was unable to correctly recite the alphabet. The 21-year-old Detroit man failed sobriety tests and was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated." Breath test results were .09%.

**E Big Beaver & Roundtree, 6/9/13, 3:26 am:** Troy Officer observed a vehicle traveling westbound in the eastbound lanes of Big Beaver. The officer activated the emergency lights and pulled in front of the vehicle. The vehicle stopped facing west in the east lanes of Big Beaver. When officers made contact with the driver he stared straight ahead and did not respond to the officers. The 30-year-old

Sterling Heights man smelled very strongly of intoxicants, his face was flushed, his eyes were glassy, red, and watery and his speech was slurred. When he exited his vehicle an officer had to hold onto his arm and guide him because he kept losing his balance. The driver was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated." Breath test results were .21%.

**Livernois & E Maple, 6/3/13, 11:40 am:** Troy Officer stopped a vehicle which was weaving. The vehicle ran over the right curb when it came to a stop. The driver, a 53-year-old Clawson woman, stumbled when getting out of her vehicle. An empty pint of vodka and 3 different prescription controlled substances were found in her vehicle. She admitted she did not have a prescription for at least one of the medications. After failing sobriety tests, she was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated" and "Possession of Schedule 4 Narcotics." Breath test results were .12%. The Clawson resident has one prior conviction for drinking and driving.

**I-75 & Crooks, 6/3/13, 6:04 pm:** Troy Officers responded to a two car non-injury accident. Witnesses reported the at-fault vehicle fished-tailed on the entrance ramp and crossed all three lanes of the freeway, colliding with a vehicle which was southbound on I-75. The at-fault driver smelled of intoxicants, had bloodshot eyes and was unsteady on his feet. Following an investigation, the 39-year-old Southfield man was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated." Breath test results were .14%.

**I-75 & W Big Beaver, 6/4/13, 8:57 am:** Troy Officers were dispatched to the area when a report was received in which a vehicle had been swerving all over the roadway then had gone into the ditch. Officers arrived and found the vehicle in the median side ditch south of Big Beaver. The driver stated he was not injured. The 41-year-old Sterling Heights male had glassy eyes, slow/slurred speech and smelled of intoxicants. He failed sobriety tests and was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated." Breath test results were .17%. The arresting officer later learned the arrestee had left his place of employment just prior to the accident on I-75. When driving out of the office parking lot, the arrestee had backed into a light pole, knocking it over, and drove over the grass.

**Rochester & Charrington, 6/5/13, 1:43 am:** Troy Officer stopped a vehicle which was weaving and made contact with the driver. The officer noted the driver smelled of intoxicants and had glassy/bloodshot eyes. The 40-year-old Findlay, Ohio resident failed all five sobriety tests and was arrested for "Operating While Intoxicated." Breath test results were .20%.

### **Home Invasions**

**1000 block of Colebrook, 6/7/13 – 6/14/13:** Copper plumbing was stolen from a vacant home. Entry was made through a rear door.

**1000 block of Axtell, 5/29/13 – 5/30/13, 5 pm - 9 am:** Complainant reports the lock/cable securing his bicycle was cut and the silver Giant Sedona was stolen from the basement of his apartment building.

**Oakland Mall, 412 W Fourteen Mile, 6/5/13, 2 pm:** A customer reported she accidentally left her cellular phone on a table in the food court. Following an investigation by Oakland Mall Security and the Troy Police Department, a 34-year-old Roseville male, who is employed as a custodian at the mall, was arrested for "Larceny in a Building". The 34-year-old works for a contracted maintenance company.

**2000 block of Coolidge, 5/8/13 – 5/9/13:** Apartment resident reports the lock was forced open on his basement storage locker and his black Trek mountain bicycle was stolen.

**2000Troy Community Center, 3179 Livernois, 6/6/13, 12:20 pm – 1:20 pm:** The Complainant reports he placed his clothing and wallet in a gym locker and secured the locker with a combination lock. When he returned to the locker room, the combination lock had been removed from his locker and his wallet was missing. The wallet contained the complainant's driver's license, three credit cards and some cash. .

Another vehicle passenger, whom the other three vehicle occupants had met at a local hotel, had an outstanding felony warrant

for parole violation. The 33 year-old Clare man was arrested on the Michigan Department of Corrections warrant for "Parole Violation/Absconder Home Invasion I".

### **Retail Fraud**

**Saks Fifth Avenue, 2901 W Big Beaver, 6/14/13, 3:05 pm:** Two 17 year-old males, both Detroit residents, were arrested by Troy Officers for "Retail Fraud II". The teens shoplifted two Burberry shirts and a pair of True Religion jeans. The total retail value of the stolen merchandise was \$529.

**Sephora, 2800 W Big Beaver, 6/15/13, 8:16 pm:** Troy Officers issued a citation for "Retail Fraud" to a 33 year-old Warren woman. Loss Prevention reports that she shoplifted nine cosmetic items which have a retail value of \$291. She concealed the merchandise in her purse.

**Kohl's, 500 John R, 6/16/13, 7:37 pm:** Two 15 year-old males, one from Warren, the other a Madison Heights resident, were detained for "Retail Fraud". Loss Prevention observed the teens enter fitting rooms after selecting several articles of clothing. When they exited the fitting rooms, neither was carrying any merchandise and no items had been left in the fitting rooms. Loss Prevention reports that the teen's legs appeared to be bulkier. They were apprehended when they exited the store and ten pieces of merchandise were recovered. The 15 year-olds were turned over to their parents and will be petitioned to Probate Court.

**JCPenney, 700 W Fourteen Mile, 6/5/13, 7:01 pm:** Troy Officer issued citations for "Retail Fraud" to two Sterling Heights women, ages 28 and 34. Both women removed JCPenney bags from their purses and placed clothing they had shoplifted inside the bags. Both women had a child with them at the time of the incident. The 34-year-old also removed shoes from the child that was with her and switched them for a new pair of Nikes. The child's old shoes were left in the Nike box. A total of \$370 worth of merchandise was stolen and recovered.

**Kohl's, 500 John R, 6/6/13, 2:19 pm:** A Troy Officer issued a citation for "Retail Fraud III" to a 37-year-old Warren woman who had shoplifted five articles of clothing. The clothing, valued at \$126.99, had been concealed in the woman's purse.

**Kohl's, 500 John R, 6/6/13, 5:30 pm:** A 30-year-old Madison Heights woman was issued a citation for "Retail Fraud III." She shoplifted three articles of clothing and one piece of jewelry with a total value of \$92.

**Macy's, 500 W Fourteen Mile, 6/7/13, 3:38 pm:** Troy Officers issued a citation for "Retail Fraud III" to a 22-year-old Pontiac woman who shoplifted a pair of shorts and a tank top. The woman concealed the merchandise in her purse.

**Nordstrom, 2850 W Big Beaver, 6/7/13, 6:59 pm:** A 19-year-old Macomb woman was issued a citation for "Retail Fraud III" after shoplifting two tank tops with a total value of \$61.

**Kroger, 1237 Coolidge Hwy, 6/3/13, 7:40 pm:** A 27-year-old Warren man was arrested for "Retail Fraud II" after shoplifting 3 packs of Red Bull energy drink. The 27-year-old has several prior arrests for retail fraud. The retail value of the stolen merchandise is \$255.85.

### **Vandalism**

**W South Blvd & Crooks, 6/5/13, 1:45 am:** Complainant states he was driving on South Blvd west of Crooks when he heard three pops. He discovered his vehicle had been struck by three orange paint balls. There was no permanent damage.

### **Miscellaneous**

**1000 block of Irene, 6/15/13, 4:36 pm:** After responding to a neighbor complaint, a Troy Officer issued a citation for "Loud Music" to a 43 year-old Troy man. He refused to turn down his music, which could be heard several trailers away, stating that he wanted to listen to it loudly because it was good music. Alcohol appeared to be a factor.

**St E Long Lake & Rochester, 6/16/13, 1:31 am:** Troy Officers were dispatched to a parking lot to meet with a cab driver. The driver stated that he had picked up a subject at a bar in Detroit and agreed to drive him to Troy. The subject appeared to be intoxicated and kept falling asleep in the back of the cab. When they got to Long Lake and Rochester, the subject got out of the cab and ran westbound – failing to pay the \$74.40 fare. The suspect is described as a white male, approximately 35 years-old with a medium build and short brown hair. He was wearing a white dress shirt and blue slacks.

**1000 block of VanCourtland, 6/6/13, 4:29 pm:** A 20-year-old Detroit male and a 27-year-old male from Berkley were issued citations for "Soliciting without a Permit." A neighbor had called police after the solicitors asked his daughter, as she walked down the street, if she was over 21-years-old. The solicitors explained they were only checking to see if she was old enough to be a sponsor for the organization they were soliciting for. Troy Officers had issued the pair a warning for the same offense the day prior.

### **Welfare Checks**

Troy Officers responded to 4 incidents involving persons with emotional or psychological issues and assisted with transport to a hospital for evaluation and possible commitment.
