# **Restaurant Depot Armed Robbery BOL**

The Troy Police Department is seeking the public's help in identifying two suspects involved in an "Armed Robbery" at the Restaurant Depot at 1304 E. Maple.

On 4/12/12 at approximately 1935 hrs, 2 B/M's entered the Restaurant Depot at closing time. One suspect armed with a black semi-auto handgun (Possibly a Glock) ordered employees to the ground. He then obtained keys for the office and ordered an employee, at gun point, to enter the room. The second suspect, apparently unarmed, (no gun seen or implied) ordered a 3<sup>rd</sup> employee to ground. The suspects stole a large amount of cash from the office, concealing bundles of cash in their pockets. The suspects fled the store out of the front entrance and preceded running east bound on foot. It is believed that both suspects possibly ran to a Dark Blue Grand Marquis, with faded paint on the hood and rear end. The vehicle had been seen waiting nearby on Allen Road just south of Maple Road.

**Suspect #1: Red vest/hoody underneath**

**Suspect #2: Dark jacket and black mask**

**Suspect #1**: 20's approx age, B/M Dark complexion 5'10-6'00, 180-200lbs

**Suspect #2**: 20's approx age, B/M Light Complexion 5'07-5'09", 150-170lbs

**Suspect Vehicle**: Mid- Late '90's Dark Crown Vic or Grand Marquis with faded paint on Hood/tail with OEM rims and possible spot light driver side.
